For the election of postgraduate students to the NUPSA Executive Committee for 2019

ELIGIBILITY

All students currently enrolled in a postgraduate course at the University of Newcastle are members of Newcastle University Postgraduate Students' Association (NUPSA) and are eligible to nominate.

There are a range of positions and you may be eligible for more than one.

a) President	f) Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander Representative - shall be a person who is of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent
b) Vice President	g) Equity Representative - shall be a person from a recognised equity group*
c) Research Representative - shall be a member enrolled in a postgraduate higher degree research program at UON	h) Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual, Transgender and Intersex (GLBTI) Representative - shall be a member of a GLBTI group who is informed about, sensitive toward and has an understanding of GLBTI groups and their issues
d) Coursework Representative - shall be a member enrolled in postgraduate coursework at UON	i) Satellite Representative - shall be a member studying primarily at a campus other than Callaghan and may be an online student
e) International Representative - shall be a member whose country of origin is other than Australia	* Equity Groups include but are not limited to people from socio-economically disadvantaged backgrounds, people from rural and isolated areas, people with a disability, people of non-English speaking backgrounds and women (especially women in non-traditional areas of study)

HOW TO NOMINATE

- Nominations must be submitted on the approved Nomination Form (page 2). There must be a separate nomination form for each candidate.
- Nominations must be proposed and seconded by two persons who are eligible for this election and with the written consent of the candidate.
- You can include a statement (300 words or less) to support your nomination, together with a passport size photograph. This will be distributed to voters in the event there is more than one eligible nomination received and we need to hold a ballot. The University Secretary reserves the right to edit a statement to ensure it contains no defamatory or offensive material.
